Themes: self-esteem, confidence, friendship, individuality, cooperation,
interdependence

Lesson/Notes: Everyone is made differently and given unique talents and gifts.

Discussion Questions

- *Was the Littlest Dragon a real dragon? (Yes, he was just different from the others.)*
- *At the beginning, how did the Littlest Dragon feel about being different?*
- *How was Little Bird a good friend?*
- *How did the Littlest Dragon help the others?*
- *Did the Littlest Dragon become big and strong like the others? (No)*
- *Was he still able to help them? (Yes)*

Activity: Super Strengths

Supplies: construction paper, markers

- Help child identify his/her own strengths (skills, positive character traits).
- Encourage child to draw him/herself as “Super (child’s name)” and write child’s “super powers” (strengths) around the drawing.
